
### BACKBONE OR NO BACKBONE

#### Grades 3RD-5TH

The animal kingdom is divided into two major groups: vertebrates and invertebrates. Vertebrates are animals with backbones, which are called vertebrae. In vertebrates, the backbones and other bones of the body form the skeleton, which provides an internal framework for the body. Invertebrates are animals without backbones. Some invertebrates have a soft body, while others have a hard outer skin or shell.
