ACHIEVE OST applicants must continue attending trainings and/or taking classes related to the youth development field in order to remain eligible for the incentive. *\*Training/education must be school-age youth development related.*

To retain eligibility, you must meet one of the following requirements in the 12 months prior to the award approval month:

- Move up a pathway level
- Complete 18 CPT hours of registry verified or non-verified trainings
- Complete one 3 credit youth development related class
- Complete one 3 credit class toward a youth development related degree

\*Youth Development related fields include, but are not limited to Education, Psychology, Social Work, Human Services and Recreation.
