- Complete 18 CPT hours of registry verified or non-verified trainings
- Complete one 3 credit youth development related class
- Complete one 3 credit class toward a youth development related degree
*Youth development related fields include, but are not limited to Education, Psychology, Social Work, Human Services and Recreation.

## ACHIEVE Out-of-school Time Guidelines

- ACHIEVE OST supplements will be paid directly to the afterschool practitioner on a bi-annual basis (subject to continued eligibility and ongoing funding).
- Participants must remain in the same afterschool program in order to be eligible for the biannual ACHIEVE OST supplement.
- There are NO requirements regarding how afterschool pracititioners use ACHIEVE OST supplements.
- This program is NOT funded by afterschool programs or employers.
- ACHIEVE OST supplements are NOT to be considered bonuses or stipends to replace employee raises.
